Borrow Pit Definitions

Potential Mine	An area which has not been mined in the past, but which proves to be a potential site for establishing a borrow pit once legal authorisations are in place.
Unconfirmed Mine	Existing borrow pit with unknown legal authorisations in place and which is not commercially operated.
Confirmed Mine	Existing borrow pit with legal authorisations, including a mining right / permit in place, but which is not commercially operated.
Commercial Quarry	Open pit mining area operating under an existing mining right, with existing infrastructure to provide aggregates to the market.
